Sixteen years after its predecessor it is finally here, the third guidebook over the amazing climbing area of Kjugekull. The book contains detailed maps over each one of the 31 sectors which make up the area, together with a handful of photo-topos of the most crowded boulders. In total there are nearly 1300 boulder problems at Kjugekull, all of them included in this guide, along with descriptions and coordinates to all sectors, a quality scale to distinguish better climbs from not so good ones and exclamation marks to identify highballs.

Included are also some lists displaying problems in different styles such as *The slabs*, *The weird ones* and the legendary *Bucket List*. A section about sectors and climbs suited for children has also been added to make planning family outings easier. Finally to top it all off the book contains over 100 beautiful coloured photographs showing off the surroundings and the most spectacular climbs!

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
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# Gamla skogen - The old forest

## Area and climbing

At the northern edge of Kjugekull lies *Gamla skogen*, an open beech forest scattered throughout with boulders in varying sizes, ranging from a few meters to as large as houses. The landings are almost always good, but some of the taller lines still require a few crash pads.

The boulder problems in this area are typical for Kjugekull, they provide lots of vertical climbing on small edges and thin cracks, favouring a strong grip and precise feet. But there are also a few demanding overhangs as well as some of the most difficult slabs found in the forest.

This part of Kjugekull is well-visited and easy to access and navigate thanks to the many well-trodden paths. The rock dries quickly, which is something to keep in mind for rainy days. Some of the boulders offer suitable climbs for children, especially those in the sector of *Ehmanns sittstart*.

All these factors make *Gamla skogen* one of the more popular areas, and for better or worse you rarely find yourself alone.


