

GLACIATED SLAB

OS Grid Ref: NY 254 128
Altitude: 300m



Approach: A path leads up into the bottom of the Combe from a grassy riverside car park 250m along the road running from Mountain View Cottages, 1 1/2 km east of Seatoller, to Thornythwaite Farm. Raven Crag dominates the head of the Combe, with the other crags to the east.

A clean, quick-drying, slabby outcrop giving relaxed climbing on superb, ice-planed rock.
